Note: United Way application requirements changed in for the 2008 and subsequent campaigns to require an accounting review. Generally accepted accounting practice requires the review to be conducted by a CPA that is independent and thus unable to provide services on a pro bono basis. The price for such a review was prohibitive, greatly exceeding the 25% maximum administrative expense allowed by United Way application requirements. In 2008, the corporation applied for United Way status with a request to waive the requirements, but was denied access. The 2009 fiscal year included only the remainder of the 2007 United Way campaign receipts, and future budgets will not include United Way grants.

\*Per direction from the membership at the Annual Meeting held in November 2005, surplus revenues are sought and will be used to build a fund of cash reserves equal to one year of budgeted expenditures. FY2008 was the first year a surplus was available (prior years showed small losses), and this directive will be included as a budget item for this and future years.
